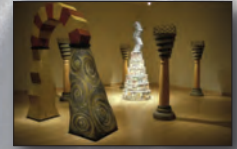

For the first time, see a visual timeline of Robert's work from the early 1980's through to the present, allowing the reader to track his development as an artist. Utilizing a wide variety of materials that have their roots in the ceramic arts, Robert explores his architectural vision through the uses of columns and arches, walls and floors, stacks and containers. X's and spirals. At mid-career his work is centered on the 'architecture of space' both indoors and out.
